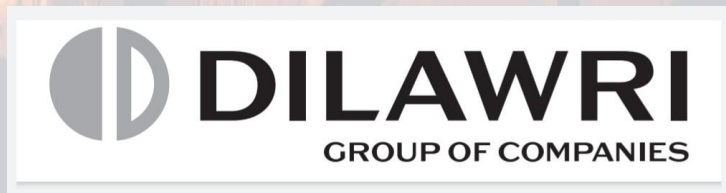

Match Briefing

Cold Range: The Regina Wildlife Federation is a cold range: Firearms may not be handled anywhere on the range except in designated safety areas, or under the direct supervision of a Range Officer. Handling firearms in parking areas is deemed unsafe gun handling.

Safety Areas: Each bay will have a safety area for handling your firearms. **NO** ammunition may be handled in safety areas.

Rules: The match will be governed under the IPSC Rulebook.

Obey Your RO's: Range Officers are responsible for ensuring safety and fair conduct during the course of fire. If you are becoming unsafe, the RO may attempt to warn you. If your firearm handling has become unsafe, you must be stopped. Upon hearing the command, "STOP!", immediately cease all movement, keep the muzzle pointing safely downrange, remove your finger from the trigger, and await further instructions from the Range Officer.

Range Communications: Please don't hesitate to ask the staff to call the Range Master if you have questions that the stage RO staff aren't able to assist with.

Setting Steel and Taping Targets: Competitors are expected to stay together as a squad to help set steel, and tape. This will help maintain efficiency on the stages, and we do appreciate your help.

Lost Brass Match: This is a "lost brass match." For the sake of match flow and to avoid delays, competitors will not be permitted to collect brass during the match.

Magazine Capacities: All firearms and magazine capacities must be Canadian legal.

Dress Code: Competitors are expected to dress in a manner appropriate to a sporting event. Military-style or tactical re-enactment attire is discouraged, as this is a competitive shooting sport, not a simulation. The Match Director reserves the right to determine the appropriateness of attire.

Scheduling: If a stage is available ahead of schedule, and the entire squad is present and ready, the squad may be permitted to shoot early with the approval of the Stage CRO.

Walk Through: Once the entire squad has assembled, the Written Stage Briefing (WSB) will be delivered by the Stage CRO, followed by a brief question period and a 4-minute stage inspection. Competitors may only negotiate obstacles during this inspection period, or as the on-deck shooter while the stage is reset and scored. Early inspection is not permitted the day before, or by the next squad scheduled to shoot the stage.

Ear and Eye Protection: All competitors must wear ear and eye protection. Safety in this regard is paramount, be on the lookout, and take appropriate action. Thanks for your help!

Match Briefing, continued

Disqualification Policy: Competitors who commit a safety violation or serious rule infraction, as defined in the IPSC Rulebook, will be disqualified and may not continue in the match. Common reasons include unsafe firearm handling, negligent discharges, or unsportsmanlike conduct. It is the competitor's responsibility to understand and follow the current IPSC rules. If a competitor wishes to dispute a disqualification, they must notify the Match Director within one hour and submit a written appeal with a \$100 CAD fee. An independent Arbitration Committee will review the appeal, and their decision is final. If the appeal is upheld, the fee will be refunded.

Competitor Agreement: By competing in this event, you attest that you have read, that you understand, and that you agree to comply with the match rules and regulations.

Changing Firearms: Competitors are expected to complete the match using the same firearm unless it becomes unserviceable or unsafe. In such cases, a replacement firearm of the same type, caliber, and division compliance may be used with prior approval from the Match Director and Range Master. Unauthorized firearm changes may result in disqualification or reclassification to the Open Division, at the discretion of the Range Master. It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure the replacement firearm is legal for their declared division.

Drawings and Dimensions: Drawings and dimensions in this booklet are approximate and may change due to safety or production considerations. Inspect each stage carefully, and listen to the written stage briefing.

Inclement Weather: Welcome to Regina. It should be sunny and warm. On the other hand, it could snow, rain, and be windy, all before noon. We'll continue the match unless it becomes a safety issue (hail, lightning, etc.)

Range Facilities

Rest Rooms: Portable toilets are located conveniently near the range.

Everyone must wear eye protection while on the range. Children must be under the direct supervision of a parent or guardian.

First Aid

First Aid: Trauma First Aid kits are located at the restrooms, and Indoor Range.
