

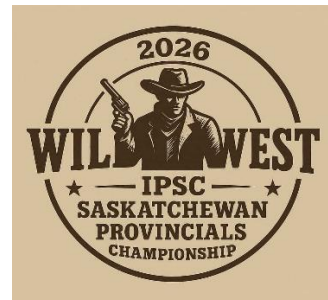

Travel East on Highway 5 from Saskatoon for ~8 miles

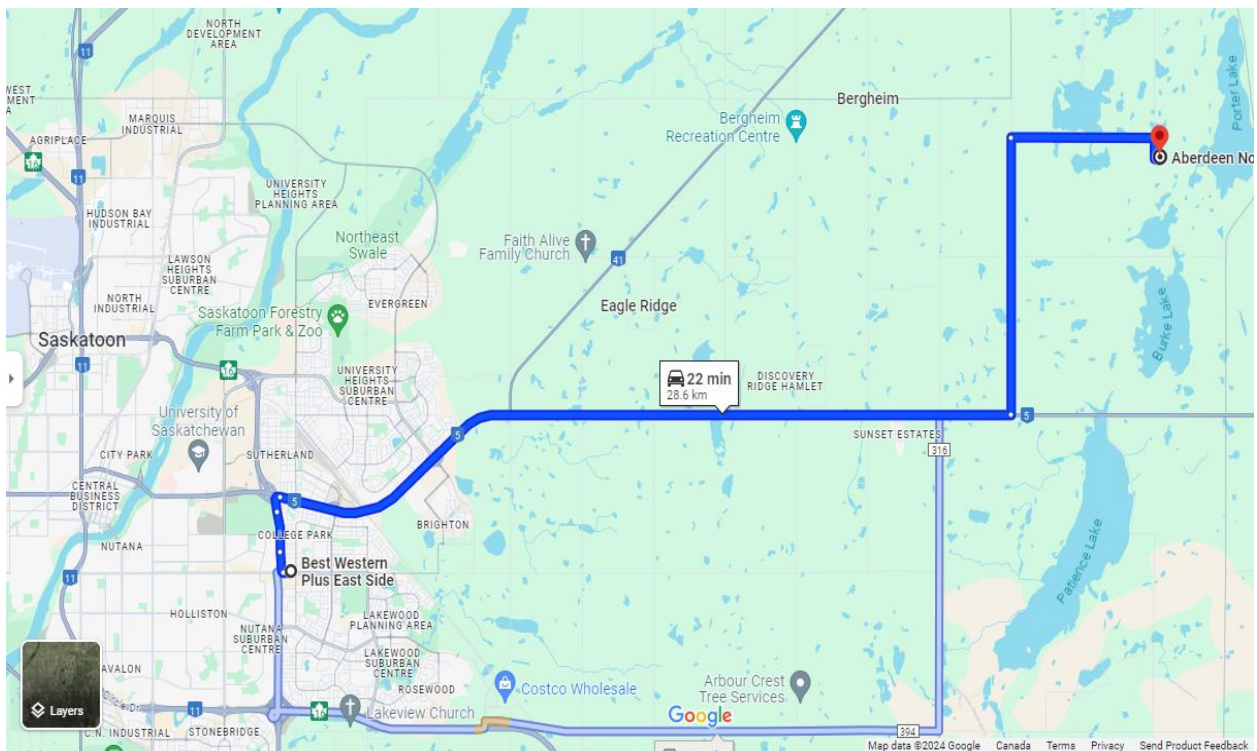
Turn North on Old 27 Road for 3 ½ miles

## Match Briefing

**Cold Range:** The Saskatoon Wildlife Federation Range is a cold range: Firearms may not be handled anywhere on the range except in designated safety areas, or under the direct supervision of a range officer. Handling firearms in parking areas is deemed unsafe gun handling.

**Safety Areas:** Each bay will have a safety area for handling your firearms. NO ammunition may be handled in safety areas.

**Rules:** The match will be governed under the IPSC Rules.

**Obey Your RO's:** Range Officers are here to assist you in safely completing a course of fire. If your firearm handling has become unsafe, you must be stopped. When you hear, "STOP!", STOP with your firearm muzzle pointing safely downrange, finger OUTSIDE the trigger guard, and await further instruction.

**Range Communications:** Please don't hesitate to ask the staff to call the Range Master if you have questions that the stage RO staff aren't able to assist with.

**Setting Steel and Taping Targets:** Competitors are expected to stay together as a squad to help set steel, and tape. This will help maintain efficiency on the stages, and we do appreciate your help.

**Lost Brass Match:** This is a "lost brass match." Picking up brass before, during or after the match is prohibited.

**Magazine Capacities:** All firearms and magazine capacities must be Canadian legal.

**Dress Code:** Please practice good taste. This is a sport, not a battle simulation / re-enactment. The match director will be final arbiter of dubious taste.

**Walk Through:** Once the entire squad has assembled, the WSB (written stage briefing) will be presented by the CRO for the stage. This will be followed by a question period, and a 3-5 minutes inspection period. Shooters may negotiate obstacles only during these 3-5 minutes period or as the on-deck shooter while targets are being scored and reset. Early inspection is permitted by the squad next scheduled to shoot a stage, provided the previous squad had completely finished, and the RO's have your squad's shooting order.

**Ear and Eye Protection:** All competitors must wear ear and eye protection. Spectators MUST have eye protection. Safety in this regard is paramount, be on the lookout, and take appropriate action. Thanks for your help!

**Disqualification Policy:** Violations of safety and sportsmanship rules will result in disqualification. Have fun, but be safe!

**Competitor Agreement:** By competing in this event, you attest that you have read, that you understand, and that you agree to comply with the match rules and regulations.

**Changing Firearms:** Changing firearms during the match without first obtaining permission is unsportsmanlike conduct. If you need to change firearms, please contact the Range Master.

**Drawings and Dimensions:** Drawings and dimensions in this booklet are approximate and may change due to safety or production considerations. Inspect each stage carefully, and listen to the written stage briefing.

**Inclement Weather:** Welcome to Saskatoon. It should be sunny and warm. On the other hand, it could snow, rain, and be windy, all before noon. We'll continue the match unless it becomes a safety issue (hail, lightning, etc.)

### **Range Facilities**

**Rest Rooms:** Portable toilets are located conveniently near the range.

**Spectators:** Everyone must wear eye protection while on the range, and hearing protection is strongly recommended. Children must be under the direct supervision of a parent or guardian.

### **First Aid / AED**

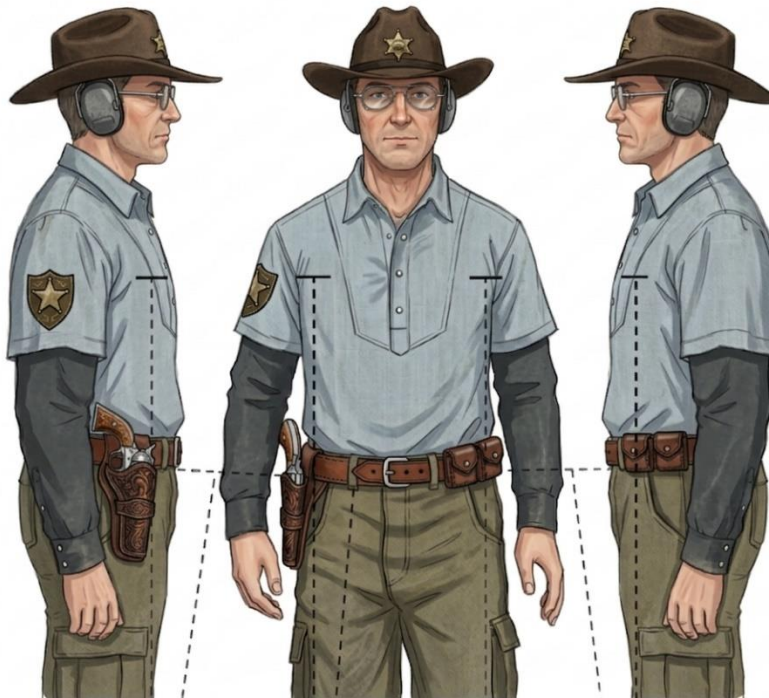
**First Aid:** A First Aid kit and AED is located at the main clubhouse.

### **Pre-Match**

**Stage Set Up:** Setup will start on Sunday, July 5th at 9 am. We would require and appreciate the local shooters to help with set up. All workers' names will be entered in special draws at the banquet.

**Competitor Ready Condition:** Rule 8.2.2 The competitor assumes the start position as specified in the written stage briefing. Unless otherwise specified, the competitor must stand erect, facing downrange, with the gun loaded and holstered, and arms hanging naturally by the sides. A competitor who attempts or completes a course of fire where an incorrect position was used may be required by a Range Officer to reshoot the course of fire.

**STAGE PROCEDURE:** Upon start signal, engage targets while holding the handle of the suit case with one hand. 1 procedural for every shot fired not holding the suit case handle. Stomp pad (SP1) activates the bobber (B1) (target remains visible at rest). Popper (P1) activates drop turner (DT1) (target is NOT visible at rest).
